



5. Non-Member Policy

Non-members who attend 'member only' or 'open' events are subject to all the policies/rules of the Quad City Singles 40 Plus club as they apply to members.

Non-members are allowed to attend 'member only events' one time per category of event. In the case where non-members attend 'member only events' more than once, the individual will be asked to leave the event by a Board member or the event Chairman, if the event is held in a private room/space reserved for Quad City Singles 40 Plus. If the event is in a public place where reserved seats have been reserved for Quad City Singles 40 Plus members, the non-member will be asked by a Board member or the event Chairman to vacate the reserved seats and sit elsewhere. If the non-member refuses to move, the management of the establishment will be contacted to handle the situation.

The Board has the right to refuse to allow the non-member to become a member of Quad City Singles 40 Plus if the non-member ignores the club's policies, rules and by laws.
